### Speaker profiles:

#### Paula Mazorra Roig

Paula Mazorra Roig is currently pursuing a Fellowship in Pediatric Oncology at the Pediatric Cancer Center Barcelona. She has a strong interest in pediatric oncology, with a particular focus on hematooncology, hematopoietic stem cell transplantation, and CAR-T therapy. Paula holds a Medical Degree from the University of Barcelona, awarded at Hospital Clínic, where she graduated with Honors in the subject of Pediatrics and completed her Pediatrics residency at Vall d'Hebron University Hospital. She is an active member of scientific societies such as the Spanish Society of Pediatrics (AEPED) and the Spanish Society of Pediatric Hematology and Oncology (SEHOP), as well as the Medical Association. In addition to her clinical work, she is actively involved in research and has contributed to studies on the management of febrile neutropenia and prophylaxis in pediatric oncology patients.

#### Tobias Feuchtinger

Prof. Dr. Tobias Feuchtinger has been Medical Director of the Department of Pediatric Hematology and Oncology at the University Hospital Freiburg since September 1, 2023. After his studies and specialist training, Feuchtinger initially conducted research at the Eberhard Karls University of Tübingen before heading the pediatric oncology department at the Dr. von Hauner Children's Hospital at the Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich from 2015. At the University Hospital Freiburg, Feuchtinger researches new therapeutic approaches and, together with an interdisciplinary team, cares for infants, children and adolescents with cancer, blood diseases and immune system diseases.

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
